Come to Southern Oregon and get in a weekend full of fun racing. We will be having Short Track and Super D races on Saturday and the epic Cross Country race on Sunday. The courses are full of great single track and fast fire roads. Come out and camp at the race venue without worrying about cooking meals - food will be available all weekend with a free post-race meal to racers on Sunday. Accommodations are available at nearby Galice Lodge.

Back by popular demand the lowest combined time for all three events will be crowned Jedi Master. There will be a \$50 prize for Cat 2 and 3 winners and a minimum purse of \$100 for the Pro / Cat 1's. Categories for Jedi Master are:

Pro Men, Pro Women, Cat1 Men, Cat1 Women,  
Cat2 Men, Cat2 Women, Cat3 Men, Cat3 Women

## **Short Track race- Saturday 10 a.m.**

1 mile loop on a gravel road, jeep trail and fast single track

## **Super D race- Saturday 4 p.m.**

Covers approx. 8 miles on 40 mph fire roads, jeep trails and single track

## **Cross Country race- Sunday 9 am**

Cat 3 will ride a fun and exciting course for approximately 14 miles mix of fire roads and plenty of single track.

Cat 2 SS and Clydesdale cover a challenging course with fire road climbs, fast descents and thrilling single track.

Cat 1-Pros are doing a 30 mile technically demanding epic course with 5800 ft of elevation gain, definitely something that will let you know you rode later in the week.

All courses end on the famous Jedi trail that is a rollercoaster of high speed groomed and banked turns for the last 3 miles leaving a big smile on racer's face!

13.5 miles to Sam Brown Campground

Right, across the bridge and then second left to parking and campground

Cat 2 = Riders looking for adventure & working on speed (*formerly Sport*)

Cat 3 = New to the sport and out for a good time (*formerly Beginner*)

Single Speed = One gear, simplicity and some pain

Clydesdale = riders weighing 200 pounds or more

**ACCIDENT WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY**

I acknowledge that this athletic event is an extreme test of a person's physical and mental limits and carries with it the potential for death, serious injury and property loss. The risks include, but are not limited to, those caused by terrain, facilities, temperature, weather, condition of athletes, equipment, vehicular traffic, actions of other people including, but not limited to, participants, volunteers, spectators, coaches, event officials and event monitors, and/or producers of the event, and lack of hydration. These risks are not only inherent to athletics, but are also present for volunteers. I hereby assume all of the risks of participating and/or volunteering in this event. I realize that liability may arise from negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities being released, from dangerous or defective equipment or property owned, maintained or controlled by them or because of their possible liability without fault.

I certify that I am physically fit, have sufficiently trained to be a participant in the event and have not been advised otherwise by a qualified medical person.

I acknowledge that this Accident Waiver and Release of Liability (AWRL) form will be used by event holders, sponsors and organizers, in which I may participate and that it will govern my actions and responsibilities at said events.

In consideration of my application and permitting me to participate in this event, I hereby take action for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns as follows: (A) Waive, Release and Discharge the Oregon Bicycling Association, their directors, officers, employees, volunteers, agents, event holders, event promoters, event sponsors, event volunteers, event permit grantors, event property owners, and event participants, from any and all liability for my death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft, lost income, or any other losses, costs or actions of any kind which hereafter may accrue to me by virtue of my training for this event, my participation in this event or my travel to or from this event; (B) Indemnify and Hold Harmless the entities or persons mentioned in this paragraph from any and all liabilities or claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of any of my actions during this event.

I hereby consent to receive medical treatment which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and or illness during this event.

I understand that at this event or related activities, I may be photographed. I agree to allow my photo, video or film likeness to be used for any legitimate purpose by the event holders, producers, sponsors, organizers and or assigns.

IMPORTANT: OBRA and the organizers of this race do not provide insurance coverage for injuries that occur at the race. The costs related to those injuries are the responsibility of the individual participant.

Bicycle use: Bicycles or bicycle equipment, wheels or other components may be loaned or borrowed for use in this event. A nominal charge may be collected to cover bicycle maintenance and purchase. This is a loan and does not constitute a rental agreement. I understand that I assume responsibility for the mechanical soundness of the bicycle and its parts, including but not limited to tires, gears, chain and bolts. I have examined or will examine the bicycle and certify that it is properly assembled and fit to ride. I accept responsibility for damaged or lost equipment.

The AWRL shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law.
